# Attn Tenants!

Georgia State Law requires that students attending public school must attend a school in the district in which they reside. When enrolling a student in public school in the state of Georgia, the guardian of the child MUST provide proof of residency. Acceptable proof of residency includes a current lease, property tax notice, homeowner's insurance bill, mortgage statement, current vehicle registration form, any utility bill listing your residence as the service address, a letter from a shelter, or a letter from your employer, if your employer provides housing.

If you have provided proof of residency to a school for your child/ward outside of the Butts County School District and did not remove the child from your dwelling lease, you have committed fraud & your rental assistance with the Jackson Housing Authority will be terminated.

Title 18, Section 1001 & 1010 of the U.S. Code states that a person is guilty of a felony for **knowingly and willingly making false or fraudulent statements to any department or agency of the United States or to the Department of Housing and Urban Development.** 

The official Code of Georgia, Section 16-9-55, as amended, states that a person is guilty of a misdemeanor for **fraudulently obtaining or attempting to obtain public housing or reduction in public housing rent.**
