As warmer weather approaches, please be mindful of our Occupancy Rules and the guidelines therein. Remember the following:

- Pools are not allowed on property
- Children under the age of 16 are not allowed to be outside without adult supervision
- Grills must be stored at the back of your property as close to the property line as possible when not in use
- Washing your vehicle is not allowed on property, neither is working on your vehicle
- Please only have approved, outside furniture on your porches
- When not in use, kids' outside toys should be stored neatly at the back of your unit
- ***Dogs are not to be left unattended or tied/chained outside***
