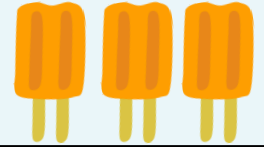

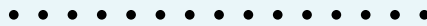

Grill Safety Reminder for Summer

As grilling season begins, please remember that all grills must be kept in the **back of your unit only**. Grills are not allowed on porches, beside porches, or in front yards.

Grilling under porch areas is a fire hazard and can cause damage to the property, which residents may be held responsible for.

Per occupancy rules:

- Only porch furniture or plants are allowed on porches/patios
- Grills may be stored behind units, not used or stored on or near porches
- Please **move any grills immediately** to the proper location to remain in compliance with housing policies.

Reminder: Guests, Gatherings & Noise

As summer approaches, residents are expected to be mindful of noise levels and respectful of neighbors when hosting gatherings. Loud parties, excessive noise, or disruptive behavior are not permitted.

Important occupancy guidelines:

- Units are to be occupied only by approved household members listed on the lease
- Guests may not stay more than **14 days per calendar year** without prior written approval.
- Residents and their guests must not disturb the comfort or rights of others.
- Alcohol use must not interfere with the health, safety, or peaceful enjoyment of the community.

Your cooperation helps maintain a safe and respectful environment for all residents.

With the heat rising, stay hydrated and report any A/C issues to the office right away. Please also continue to observe quiet hours, even with more flexible summer schedules.

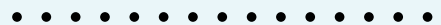

The program will run from June 1st through July 31st and is a great opportunity to help ensure children have access to nutritious meals throughout the summer months.

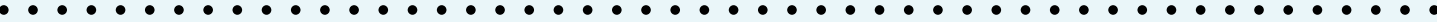
