

The deadline to register your vehicle at the office was 12/15/24. All vehicles that do not have decals by 1/1/25 will be towed at the owners expense. Each household is permitted 1 vehicle. Any household that has multiple vehicles awaiting approval— your letter will be sent out the 1st week of January.

Documents required for decal include:

- Valid Drivers License
- Valid insurance
- Tag registration receipt.
