



REMINDERS

- Summer break is here, please ensure that children are supervised at all times. Parents are responsible for any damages caused by their children and guests. Tenants should respect their neighbors and keep noise to a minimum. Between the hours of 10PM-7AM, outside noise should be omitted and inside noise should be kept to a minimum. We cannot stress this enough! Tenants are instructed to call the police at anytime, then contact your housing manger regarding situations/disturbances.
- Pools are not allowed for safety and liability reasons per your lease agreement. NO EXCEP-TIONS.
- Please do not feed the animals. Warmer temperatures means you might see all types of wildlife. This includes stray cats and dogs.
 Snakes, racoons, foxes, and coyotes are more likely to appear if food bowls are left out.
 Please make sure that trash is contained and any debris is cleaned up to prevent unwanted critters.
- Avoid a \$50 fee by not parking on the grass!
 NO EXCEPTIONS!
- **NO SMOKING**. Do not smoke/vape inside unit, on porches, or anywhere on housing authority property. If you, or your guests, are seen smoking on the property, a smoking fee will be sent.

Summer Reminders:

• Air Conditioning Units: Please keep in mind that for maximum efficiency your A/C should be kept at 78 degrees throughout the summer months. Also, please do not set your AC unit below 73 degrees as it can freeze up the unit and cause it not to work properly.

• **Pest Prevention:** Warmer weather can bring pests. Please keep food sealed, trash disposed of properly, and report any signs of insects or rodents to the office right away.

• **Grilling Policy:** For safety reasons, grilling too close to the building is not permitted.

• **Noise Levels:** Windows are often open during summer, so please be mindful of noise levels, especially in the evenings.

• **Children at Play:** We love seeing kids enjoying the outdoors! Please remind children to be careful near parking lots and to respect neighbors' property and space. As always, remember that children should not be outside without adult supervision.

Don't forget, if your household has any changes in income, employment, or family composition, you should notify the office right away so we can keep your file up to date and adjust your rent as needed..
