Let's make this a safe, sunny, and neighborly July!

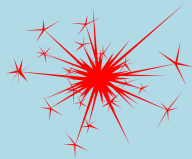

Maintenance will be conducting inspections in preparation for inspire inspections taking place this year. We will be checking windows and doors for proper operation. We will also be checking stoves and refrigerators. All damages will be noted and either repaired or scheduled for later repair depending on severity and importance of inspection. 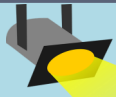
