As we step into November, we want to take a moment to express our gratitude for each of our residents. This is a season for reflection, thankfulness, and preparation — both for the holidays ahead and for closing out the year strong.

Important Reminders:

- * If you have not yet completed your **annual recertification**, please contact the office **immediately**. All recertifications must be completed **no later than November 30th**. Failure to do so will result in your rent automatically converting to **market rent** until your recertification is complete. We want to help you avoid any interruption to your housing assistance, so please reach out as soon as possible.
 - * As cooler weather sets in, please help us keep the property safe and clean. Dispose of leaves and debris properly, report any maintenance concerns promptly, and check your heaters and weather stripping to ensure your unit stays warm.
 - * If you are not sure how you will afford to feed your household as the government shutdown causes a delay in SNAP benefits being released, please reach out to BeLinda, our resident services coordinator. She has the most current resources available to help you.
 - * **DO NOT place trash on the curbs**. Trash, including bags, boxes, and loose trash, should be brought to the office during business hours to be placed in the dumpster. Any items too large to fit in the dumpster should be set out at the road the night before pickup. Please call City Hall to get the pickup day. We want to keep our community looking beautiful, and this will be a huge help.
 - * Lastly, with the holidays approaching, please be mindful of guests, noise levels, and parking courtesy. Let's continue to make our community a welcoming and peaceful place for all our neighbors. Wishing each of you a safe, warm, and thankful November!

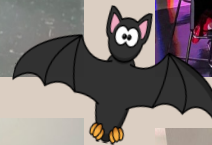
